1. PARAGRAPH NUMBER AND TITLE:

2-1-18. LAND-BASED AIR DEFENSE IDENTIFICATION ZONE (ADIZ)/SPECIAL FLIGHT RULES AREA (SFRA)/AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL (ATC) SECURITY SERVICES

2. <u>BACKGROUND</u>: On Febuary 17, 2009, the Washington DC ADIZ was changed by rulemaking to the Special Flight Rules Area (SFRA). The procedures that will be used for the SFRA are the same as for a land based ADIZ. Additionally, since Washington ARTCC may have to assume the airspace if Potomac TRACON went ATC-0, the reference to Terminal was deleted.

3. <u>EXPLANATION OF CHANGE</u>: This change replaces Land Based Air Defense Identification Zone with Washington DC SFRA. This change cancels and incorporates N JO 7210.713, Washington D.C., Special Flight Rules Area (DC SFRA)/ATC Security Services, effective May 11, 2009
