Add TARMAC DELAY REQUEST - A request by

> the pilot-in-command to taxi to the ramp, gate, or alternate deplaning location to comply with

the Three-hour Tarmac Rule.

THREE-HOUR TARMAC RULE - Rule that Add

> relates to Department of Transportation (DOT) requirements placed on airlines when tarmac delays are anticipated to reach 3 hours.
