BACKGROUND: In light of several recent loss of communication events in the National Airspace System, a multidisciplinary team reviewed and analyzed how to improve air traffic control operations regarding the establishment, transfer, and loss of communications with aircraft. - 3. **EXPLANATION OF CHANGE:** The change adds the requirement for controllers to take appropriate action to establish communications with aircraft within a reasonable amount of time. This change cancels and incorporates N JO 7110.535, Aircraft Communication Status, effective October 1, 2010.
