1. PARAGRAPH NUMBER AND TITLE:

20-4-1. DOMESTIC EVENTS NETWORK (DEN)

- **2. BACKGROUND:** The original intent was to have all security related incidents reported on the DEN. The reference to CONUS created a large gap in the NAS for reporting security related incidents. Also, System Operations Security has been given the authority to direct field facilities to participate on the DEN during security related incidents.
- **3. EXPLANATION OF CHANGE:** This change removes the reference to CONUS for reporting security related incidents on the DEN and, when directed by System Operations Security or the DEN ATSC, what field facilities will participate on the DEN. This change cancels and incorporates N JO 7210.724, Domestic Events Network and Presidential/USSS Supported VIP Movement, effective September 30, 2009.

20-4-1. DOMESTIC EVENTS NETWORK (DEN)

- a. Domestic Event Network (DEN). A 24/7 FAA sponsored telephonic conference call network that includes all of the air route traffic control centers (ARTCC) in the U.S. It also includes various other governmental agencies that monitor the DEN. The purpose of the DEN is to provide timely notification to the appropriate authority that there is an emerging air-related problem or incident within the CONUS. The DEN is managed and facilitated by ATSCs under the direction of Tactical Operations Security.
- b. Required ATC Facility DEN participation

- 3. Approach control facilities <u>shall</u> participate on the DEN during President of the United States (POTUS) TFRs <u>or</u> National Special Security Events (NSSEs) affecting their area.
- 4. ATCT <u>shall</u> participate on the DEN during arrival and departure phase of POTUS, Vice President of the United States (VPOTUS) <u>and</u> First Lady of the United States (FLOTUS) movements.

20-4-1. DOMESTIC EVENTS NETWORK (DEN)

- a. Domestic Event Network (DEN). A 24/7 FAA sponsored telephonic conference call network (recorded) that includes all of the air route traffic control centers (ARTCC) in the United States. It also includes various other Governmental agencies that monitor the DEN. The purpose of the DEN is to provide timely notification to the appropriate authority that there is an emerging air-related problem or incident.
