1. PARAGRAPH NUMBER AND TITLE:

5-3-3. DEFENSE VISUAL FLIGHT RULES (DVFR)

2. BACKGROUND: Upgrades to the operational system used by flight services in Alaska have eliminated the need for the exception placed upon Alaska in the handling of DVFR flight plans.

3. EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: References to Alaska are removed from the paragraph. This change cancels and incorporates N JO 7610.89, Defense Visual Flight Rules (DVFR), effective April 15, 2010.

4. CHANGE:

5-3-3. DEFENSE VISUAL FLIGHT RULES (DVFR)

Instruct pilots to contact Flight Service for DVFR flight plan filing and activation procedures. Except for Alaska, Flight Service shall assign beacon codes and forward all required information to NORAD. Detailed DVFR flight plan procedures are contained in FAAO 7110.10, Flight Services and in Alaskan Letters of Agreement.

NEW

5-3-3. DEFENSE VISUAL FLIGHT RULES (DVFR)

Instruct pilots to contact Flight Service for DVFR flight plan filing and activation procedures. Flight Service **must** assign beacon codes and forward all required information to NORAD. Detailed DVFR flight plan procedures are contained in FAAO 7110.10, Flight Services.


