Instrument Procedures Development

Please cancel FAA Order 8260.40B, Flight Management System (FMS) Instrument Procedures Development. This order provides criteria for establishing instrument area navigation (RNAV) approach, transition to instrument landing system (ILS) precision final approach, and departure and missed approach procedures for FMS-equipped aircraft.

All of the applicable content has been incorporated into FAA Order 8260.58, United States Standard for Performance-based Navigation (PBN) Instrument Procedure Design. Therefore, this order requires cancellation.
