Pack Safe Guide

Properly [pack your bags](#) before reaching security checkpoints to avoid delays or property confiscation.

Bag Placement Rules

- **Carry-on Only:** Spare lithium ion and lithium metal batteries, including power banks, e-cigarettes and cell phone battery charging cases, must be carried in carry-on baggage only.
- **Liquids (3-1-1 Rule):** Containers must be a maximum of 3.4 oz (100ml) and fit inside one clear, quart-sized plastic bag for carry-ons.

Strictly Prohibited Items

The following items are banned from both carry-on and checked luggage: Fireworks, sparklers, flares, camp fuel, lighter fluid, certain lighters, chlorine, bleach, toxic chemicals, or poisons.

Dangerous Behavior Doesn't Fly

The FAA takes [unruly passenger](#) behavior seriously. Passengers who interfere with crew duties or disrupt a flight may face substantial penalties, including fines, criminal prosecution, and limits on future travel.

The FAA can propose up to \$43,658 per violation for unruly passenger cases. One incident can result in multiple fines.

Airport & Security

Expect major airport delays due to millions of fans traveling across the 11 U.S. host cities.

Action Required:

Always check your flight status with your airline before leaving for the airport.

No Drone Zone



"No Drone Zones"

Drones are [heavily restricted](#) throughout the tournament to ensure public safety. Leave your drones at home or in your hotel room.

- **Strict Prohibitions:** All stadiums and official fan events are completely restricted zones. On match days, a 3-nautical-mile flight restriction is strictly enforced around all venues.
- **Enforcement:** U.S. Law enforcement utilizes advanced technology to track, locate, and intercept unauthorized drones.
- **Consequences:** Operating a drone inside a restricted area carries severe penalties.
 - **Fines:** Civil penalties up to \$75,000 per violation, criminal fines up to \$100,000.
- **Criminal Prosecution:** Violators may face federal criminal charges and immediate arrest.
