## When in doubt, leave it out!

### DO NOT PACK IN CHECKED LUGGAGE

This list is not all-inclusive.

#### Fireworks:

Signal flares, firecrackers, sparklers or other explosives

#### Weapons:

Ammunition\*, gunpowder, mace\*, tear gas or pepper spray\*

#### Lithium Batteries:

e-cigarettes, power banks, spare lithium batteries, devices with a lithium ion battery that exceeds 100 watt hours (Wh)\*

#### Household Items:

Drain cleaners and solvents

Most hazardous materials are forbidden in carry-on and checked baggage. There are a few exceptions for some personal items such as toiletries, medicines, battery powered electronics and assistive devices. Remember, this is just a listing of common hazardous materials; if you don't see your item here it doesn't mean it's allowed in baggage. Check the PackSafe website or call your airline for exceptions.

#### Compressed Gases:

Spray cans\*, butane fuel, pressurized scuba tanks, propane tanks, oxygen bottles, self-inflating rafts, flammable aerosols

#### Other Hazardous Materials:

Dry ice\*, gasoline powered tools, camping equipment with fuel, wet-cell batteries\*, oxidizers, corrosives, radioactive materials (including radio-pharmaceuticals), poisons, infectious substances
