Notice of Invalidity of Registration Pertaining
to Civil Aircraft N26674

Please take notice that pursuant to 47.43(a)(3) of the Federal Aviation Regulations, the Certificate of Aircraft Registration issued for Civil Aircraft N26674, a Cessna-Reims FR 172J, aircraft serial number 0489, is determined to be invalid.

Incident thereto, Van Dusen Aeroport Services, Inc., made application for and was issued a Certificate of Aircraft Registration for Civil Aircraft N26674 on February 2, 1982. In so doing, you certified that you were eligible to register the aircraft based on your United States citizenship.

Information has now come to the attention of the FAA Aircraft Registry that Van Dusen Aeroport Services, Inc., is not a United States citizen, but is a citizen of France. On March 8, 1988, the Registry received a request for a name change in the Certificate of Registration. Because the Certificate is invalid, the change would not be appropriate.

Under Section 47.43(a)(3) of the Federal Aviation Regulations, an aircraft registered to an applicant who is not qualified to submit an application at the time of registration, renders U.S. registration invalid. Section 501(b) of the Federal Aviation Act (49 U.S.C. 1401(b)) states that an aircraft shall be eligible for registration if, but only if, it is owned by (among other specified eligibles) a citizen of the United States.

Van Dusen Aeroport Services, Inc., must return the Certificate of Aircraft Registration for Civil Aircraft N26674 to the FAA Aircraft Registry in accordance with 14 CFR 47.43(b). If you have any questions, please call me at (405) 686-2296.
