Artisan Lien on N744JR


Your lien submitted on this aircraft by Fred Sarrach of Collinsville, Illinois, against Robbie Airways Corporation, of Wilmington, Delaware, under the laws of the State of Florida, has been referred to this office for review. We are concerned that an ostensible citizen of Illinois attempts to assert a lien under Florida law against a legal entity of a third state, without some nexus or relationship to the protection of those laws.

If the work were done in Florida, and the lien so stated, we would have no problems, but we are frankly having difficulty determining how an Illinois citizen avails himself of another state's protective statutes.

Please ask your client to submit some documentation that he is eligible to use Florida laws on a Delaware company from Illinois. We note that Illinois has an artisan lien recording statute that could be applicable, but we are sure that the facts of the matter will make interesting reading.
