Receipt is acknowledged of your Lis Pendens Notice (84 SC 3406) indicating that a Complaint for Breach of Contract pertaining to civil aircraft N3884V was filed in the Circuit Court of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, Lake County, Illinois.
