Dear Mr. Hall:

This is in reply to your letter of July 17, 1970 in which you requested our review of a Voting Trust Agreement in regards to its compliance with the citizenship requirements under the Federal Aviation Act of 1958, as amended.

We have reviewed the subject Voting Trust Agreement and find it to be generally acceptable for the purpose of meeting the definition of U.S. citizenship set forth in Section 101(13) of the Federal Aviation Act of 1958. There are several minor suggested changes which we would recommend be incorporated into the Agreement:

1. We note in your letter that Laredo Aviation Services, Inc. is a Texas corporation. Since Section 101(13) requires the corporation to be organized under the laws of the United States, we recommend that this fact be set forth specifically in the Trust Agreement.
2. It is recommended that the Trust Agreement include an appendix which would list the names, addresses, and citizenship of the stockholders, trustees, and principal officers of the corporation.
3. Your letter sets forth most of the above information with the exception of the citizenship of the principal officers of the corporation, other than the president of Laredo Aviation Services, Inc. If there are any other principal officers (i.e., vice president, secretary, and treasurer) they should be included in the above-mentioned appendix. It is necessary that two-thirds of all of the principal officers be citizens of the United States.

We are forwarding a copy of our reply, together with the subject Trust Agreement, to the FAA Aircraft Registry at the Aeronautical Center. It

is suggested that, once the Trust Agreement has been revised in accordance with the above comments, you forward the original and a signed duplicate to the FAA Aircraft Registry, Attention: Mr. Lester G. Robinson.
