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SGT, Inc. (“SGT”) filed this protest to challenge the determinations and reevaluations rendered after an order of corrective action in a prior protest under Solicitation Number DTFAWA-16-R-00010-003. *See Protest of SGT, Inc.*, 17-ODRA-00814; *Administrator’s Order*, ODRA-19-860. Specifically, SGT contested the Product Team’s decision to affirm its award of the Traffic Flow Management (“TFM-2”) contract to CSRA, Inc. (“CSRA”). SGT challenged the contracting officer’s waiver of CSRA’s unmitigated organizational conflicts of interest (“OCI”) and the partial technical and risk reevaluations of its proposal.

The Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) adjudicated the Protest and found that the contracting officer’s OCI waiver lacked a rational basis. Because the ODRA found the first issue dispositive, the ODRA did not reach SGT’s remaining challenges.

I adopt and incorporate by reference the attached Findings and Recommendations of the ODRA. For the reasons set forth therein, I sustain the Protest and adopt the recommended remedies. Further, as recommended in the Findings and Recommendations, the ODRA

retains jurisdiction to adjudicate the final amount for proposal preparation costs. I direct the ODRA to establish a schedule for further proceedings on this issue. Additionally, I direct that the Product Team complete the remaining corrective remedies in the manner and timeframe recommended by the ODRA in the Findings and Recommendations.
