ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

By letter dated February 8, 2002, Stambaugh's Air Service, Inc., ("Stambaugh's") withdrew its petition for reconsideration of the Administrator's decision and order issued on May 16, 2001, denying Stambaugh's appeal and affirming the administrative law judge's initial decision assessing a \$900 civil penalty.
