ORDER

Adsystech, Inc. (“Adsystech”) filed the initial bid protest and supplemental protest (collectively referenced as the “Protests”) in this matter on December 2, 2009, and February 8, 2010, respectively. Adsystech challenged the award of a contract to Jerry Thompson and Associates, Inc. by the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) pursuant to Solicitation No. DTFawa-07-R-00024. The Solicitation in question was issued to obtain “Financial Analysis and Support Services” for the FAA’s Air Traffic Organization.

The Protests contain eleven counts that generally allege bias, favoritism, deviation from the Acquisition Management System, and erroneous evaluations. The Product Team has filed a Request for Dismissal of Counts Nine, Ten, and Eleven. For the reasons set forth therein, I adopt and incorporate by reference the attached Findings and Recommendation of the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”), and hereby: (1) partially sustain Adsystech’s Protest; and (2) direct that a new Contracting Officer and Evaluation Team be appointed to implement the remedy recommended by the ODRA.

This is the final Agency Order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. § 46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. § 17.33, within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.
