ORDER

Aviation Management Inc., LLC (“AMI”) filed this Bid Protest (“Protest”) with the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) on July 13, 2015. The Protest challenges the Western Area Service Center’s (the “Center”) award of a purchase order to acquire signal light guns, chargers, batteries, and lamps. Previously, based on a motion from the Center, the ODRA partially dismissed untimely challenges to the terms of the solicitation. The remaining protest ground, concerning whether the Center erred in its evaluation of AMI’s quoted equipment and price, was adjudicated on the merits.

Pursuant to a Delegation of final decisional authority from the FAA Administrator,* I adopt and incorporate herein the ODRA’s *Decision on Motion to Dismiss Protest as Untimely and Meritless* (October 14, 2015), and the attached Findings and Recommendations and deny the Protest in its entirety.

* Final decisional authority over bid protests involving acquisitions valued at not more than twenty million dollars has been delegated to the ODRA Director. See Delegation of Authority, dated March 19, 2014.

This is the final Agency Order in this matter. Any review of this Order shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. §17.43 (2015), within sixty (60) days of service of this Order.
