

# New Zealand COVID-19


- New Zealand is now at Alert Level 1.
- No new cases in the community, only cases in managed Isolation facilities (Returning New Zealanders from overseas, 14 day quarantine).
- A travel bubble between New Zealand, Australia and the Cook Islands has been operating since April 2020.
  - At present the travel bubble is suspended between New Zealand / South Australia, Victoria and New South Wales due to COVID-19 Delta variant community cases.
- New Zealand vaccine roll out is gaining in numbers, 17% 1 dose and 11.5% fully vaccinated. Aim to have 100% by the end of this year.
- Auckland Oceanic controllers now working full rosters with minor changes to finish times to reflect reduced Oceanic traffic levels.

# Auckland Oceanic Traffic levels 2021


Auckland Oceanic - Daily Flights 2021


