Pope Benedict XVI DC Visit FLIGHT ADVISORY

This advisory will serve as notice of restrictions that will be in place for the visit of Pope Benedict to Washington, DC on April 17th, 2008. There will be two Notices to Airmen (NOTAMs) issued to cover the events.

Both NOTAMS will contain the following standard 91.141 advisory language;

Pursuant to 49 USC 40103(B), the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) classifies the airspace defined in this NOTAM as "National Defense Airspace". Any person who knowingly or willfully violates the rules concerning operations in this airspace may be subject to certain criminal penalties under 49 USC 46307. Pilots who do not adhere to the following procedures may be intercepted, detained and interviewed by Federal Law Enforcement/Security Personnel. *And* pursuant to title 14 section 91.141 code of federal regulations (CFR).

The first NOTAM, FDC 8/2874, will be in effect on April 17, 2008, from 0900-1245 Local, for the Pope's visit to Washington National's Stadium.

WITHIN A .5 NMR OF 385225N/0770028W OR THE DCA067001.6 UP TO AND INCLUDING 3000 FT MSL

EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED BELOW AND/OR UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE AIR TRAFFIC SECURITY COORDINATOR VIA THE DOMESTIC EVENTS NETWORK (DEN):

ALL AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS WITHIN THE AREA LISTED ABOVE ARE PROHIBITED EXCEPT FOR APPROVED; LAW ENFORCEMENT AIRCRAFT IN DIRECT SUPPORT OF THE UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE (USSS), MILITARY AIRCRAFT ON ACTIVE INTERCEPT MISSIONS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL FLIGHTS ARRIVING AND DEPARTING THE SOUTH CAPITOL STREET HELIPORT (09W).

1. EMERGENCY MEDICAL FLIGHTS MUST CONTACT THE FAA REPRESENTATIVE AT THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION COORDINATION CENTER (NCRCC) AT 866-598-9522 PRIOR TO THEIR DEPARTURE TO AVOID POTENTIAL DELAYS.
2. EMERGENCY MEDICAL FLIGHTS ENTERING OR EXITING THE TFR MUST HAVE A DISCRETE CODE ASSIGNED BY AN AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL (ATC) FACILITY. AIRCRAFT MUST BE SQUAWKING THE DISCRETE CODE PRIOR TO DEPARTURE AND AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE TFR AND MUST REMAIN IN TWO-WAY RADIO COMMUNICATIONS WITH ATC.

NOTE: All aircraft operations not specifically mentioned above are prohibited.

The second NOTAM, FDC 8/2880, will be in effect on April 17, 2008, from 1630-1945 Local, for the Pope's visit to Catholic University.

WITHIN A .5 NMR OF 385610N/0770007W OR THE DCA028004.9 UP TO AND INCLUDING 3000 FT MSL

EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED BELOW AND/OR UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE AIR TRAFFIC SECURITY COORDINATOR VIA THE DOMESTIC EVENTS NETWORK (DEN):

ALL AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS WITHIN THE AREA LISTED ABOVE ARE PROHIBITED EXCEPT FOR APPROVED; LAW ENFORCEMENT AIRCRAFT IN DIRECT SUPPORT OF THE UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE (USSS), MILITARY AIRCRAFT ON ACTIVE INTERCEPT MISSIONS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL FLIGHTS ARRIVING AND DEPARTING THE WHC HELIPORT (DC08) AND CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL HELIPORT (DC17).

1. EMERGENCY MEDICAL FLIGHTS MUST CONTACT THE FAA REPRESENTATIVE AT THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION COORDINATION CENTER (NCRCC) AT 866-598-9522 PRIOR TO THEIR DEPARTURE TO AVOID POTENTIAL DELAYS.
2. EMERGENCY MEDICAL FLIGHTS ENTERING OR EXITING THE TFR MUST HAVE A DISCRETE CODE ASSIGNED BY AN AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL (ATC) FACILITY. AIRCRAFT MUST BE SQUAWKING THE DISCRETE CODE PRIOR TO DEPARTURE AND AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE TFR AND MUST REMAIN IN TWO-WAY RADIO COMMUNICATIONS WITH ATC.

NOTE: All aircraft operations not specifically mentioned above are prohibited.
