


# MAMERC SELF RE-ENROLLMENT

The following steps cover re-enrolling in the class. This process is intended for use once the course has been completed, and it is time to take it again.


**Note: If you have already enrolled in the course, but have not completed it, simply navigate to the main menu and click “Launch” under the heading “Current Enrollments”.**

1. Navigate to <http://deliver.courseavenue.com/Login.aspx?o=cami>
  - This will take you to the Main Menu of the FAA CAMI eLearning System.
2. Click on “ View My Catalogs” in the “Learner” column.



3. The “Catalog List” page appears.

4. Click the folder icon “” in the right hand column next to the “MAMERC” catalog.
  - This will load the “Course Enrollment List” page.
