TRAINING PROGRAM UPDATES AND INFORMATION

ANNUAL TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Annually engineering designees are required to complete:

- Recurrent Engineering Designee Seminar course (ex 27200200 2026 Engineering Designee Seminar); AND
- Select and complete one elective in each discipline they are authorized.

Recurrent training enrollment occurs in two phases:

- Enroll, pay for, and complete the Recurrent Engineering Designee Seminar course; then
- Enroll in your discipline specific training course and select the elective you plan to complete.

Discipline Specific training for 2026 Includes

- 2026 Recurrent Training for Acoustic Designees (DERs and UMs)
- 2026 Recurrent Training for Electrical Engineering Designees (DERs and UMs)
- 2026 Recurrent Training for Flight Test Engineering Designees (DERs and UMs)
- 2026 Recurrent Training for Mechanical Systems Engineering Designees (DERs and UMs)
- 2026 Recurrent Training for Powerplant, Engine and Propeller Engineering Designees (DERs and UMs)
- 2026 Recurrent Training for Structures Engineering Designees (DERs and UMs)

THE DESIGNEE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (DMS) TRAINING MODULE

The Designee Registration System (DRS) has been decommissioned. Beginning in January of 2026 all designee training will be accessed through the new Training Module in DMS. Details on the DMS Training Module can be found below.

TRANSITION FROM MYACCESS TO LOGIN.GOV

FAA MyAccess has been replaced by Login.gov as the multi-factor login solution. Students may be familiar with login.gov as it is used by other Federal Government entities (ex. Social Security Administration). More details on login.gov and MyAccess account migration can be found below.


