

What do I do as an AME if my pilot tells me they've had a recent* DUI?

*within the past 5 yrs

Find out if they've had any prior DUI offenses



The National Driver Registry (NDR) does a check automatically, but will not show offenses outside the statute of limitations, or in a different state.

Alcohol Event Status Report for the AME

14 days & 60 days FAA Security Requirements:

The pilot must notify FAA Security (AMC-700) of any conviction or administrative action for DUI/DWI.

This is mandated by statute: 14 CFR part 61.15. The Notification letter must be filled in and submitted within 60 days of the motor vehicle conviction or administrative action for DUI/DWI.

Reminder: Tell the pilot if the DUI/DWI is over 60 days old that they must submit the Notification to Security anyway.

A. **Airman Statement:** current consumption of alcohol and drugs

B. **BAC > .15 =** defer to FAA
Blood Alcohol Content

C. **Court/Police Reports**
results of field sobriety tests
breathalyzer results
if they refused a test

D. **Driving Record**

E. **Evidence of Treatment**

refusal to test = positive test

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
