Re: Pilot Records Database (PRD) Will Migrate API Client to Gravitee

This message is for Air Carrier and Operator using the FAA API Client in the Pilot Records Database (PRD).

Upcoming Changes to the FAA API Management Platform

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is updating its Application Programming Interface (API) management platform, transitioning from MuleSoft to Gravitee. Companies utilizing the FAA API Client should inform their API Technical Teams about this transition.

Rollout Plan

The transition to Gravitee will commence on April 6, 2026. During this time, all existing user accounts will be migrated from the MuleSoft platform to Gravitee. Please anticipate a temporary outage of the API client during the migration process.

Impact on Companies Using the FAA API Client for PRD

Expect a brief outage during the migration. Your account information, including user details, Client ID, and Client secret, will be seamlessly transferred from MuleSoft to Gravitee. Current API endpoints will remain unchanged.

Post-Migration Expectations

Air carriers and operators using the FAA API Client should not experience any changes after the migration. If issues arise following the temporary outage, please first consult your company's API Technical Team. Should problems persist, contact the FAA for further assistance.
