Pilot Records Database Final Phase of Implementation Update

Reminder: Upcoming Milestones for the Pilot Records Database (PRD)

As we approach the full implementation of the Pilot Records Database (PRD) in September 2024, we want to remind our stakeholders of the key upcoming milestones and important information:

- September 9, 2024: Required air carriers/operators must finish entering historical records dated between August 1, 2005 December 31, 2014. Refer to <u>AC 120-68J (faa.gov)</u>, Table 2-1: PRD Overview of Record Reporting by Population.
- After September 9, 2024:
 - FAA Form 8060-12 will no longer be applicable. More information is available in our <u>Frequently Asked Questions</u>.
 - The option to send FAA Form 8060-11 will end. Pilot records must be entered into the PRD in response to a records request. See <u>AC 120-68J</u> (faa.gov), paragraph 2.10: Transitioning From PRIA to the PRD, for more details.
