#### What is it?

#### **Configuration Change Request (CCR)**

A Certificate Holder defines the scope of Operations with the FAA by submitting a Configuration Change Request.

#### **After the Configuration Change Request**

The FAA will review a Configuration Change Request using the same approval process as the initial Configuration data approval.

	28. Verify in the Confirmation window that, "I have considered if the application of SRM is required for the change(s) in operation(s). I am now ready to initiate configuration changes in SAS." Select the <b>OK</b> button.
Certificate Holders	29. In the Message window, "This will submit the Change Request," select the Submit button.
	30. When configuration change request has been successfully submitted to the FAA, a green confirmation message will appear, "Change Request Successfully Submitted."

#### Confirmation
