2. This certificate shall be presented for inspection upon the request of any authorized representative of the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration, or of any State or municipal official charged with the duty of enforcing local laws or regulations.
3. The holder of this certificate shall be responsible for the strict observance of the terms and provisions contained herein.
4. This certificate is nontransferable.

NOTE—This certificate constitutes a waiver of those Federal rules or regulations specifically referred to above. It does not constitute a waiver of any State law or local ordinance.

## SPECIAL PROVISIONS

**Special Provisions Nos. 1 to 21**, inclusive, are set forth on the attached pages.

This Certificate of Waiver is effective from Sept 23, 2026, to Sept 22, 2028, and is subject to cancellation at any time upon notice by the Administrator or an authorized representative.

## SPECIAL PROVISIONS ISSUED TO Anduril

### General.

The FAA's Flight Standards Service has reviewed your application to ensure compliance with the requirements of 14 CFR § 107.200 and § 107.205. Pursuant to these authorities, the Administrator finds that the proposed small unmanned aircraft (sUA) operation can be conducted safely under the provisions of this Certificate of Waiver (Waiver) as listed below because you have established adequate mitigations for risks involved with operating your sUA in the manner you described. Adherence to the provisions of this Waiver establishes the required level of safety within the national airspace system.

The Administrator may cancel this Waiver at any time. As a general rule, this Waiver may be canceled when it is no longer required, there is an abuse of its provisions, or when unforeseen safety factors develop. Failure to comply with any provision listed below is a violation of the terms of this Waiver and will serve as justification for cancellation.

List of Regulations Waived by Section and Title. The following regulations are waived:

- **14 CFR § 107.51(b), Operating limitations for small unmanned aircraft - Altitude, is waived to allow sUAS operations higher than 400 feet above ground level (AGL), not to exceed 7000 feet AGL**

**Common Special Provisions.** The Responsible Person is directly responsible for safety of operations conducted under this Waiver and will ensure the Remote Pilot in Command (remote PIC), manipulator of the controls, and visual observer(s) (VO)<sup>1</sup> comply with all provisions of this Waiver.

1. The Responsible Person listed on the Waiver is responsible to the FAA for the safe conduct of the operations. Prior to conducting operations that are the subject of this Waiver, the Responsible Person:
  - a. Must ensure the remote PIC, manipulators of the controls, and VO(s) are informed of the terms and provisions of this Waiver and strictly observe the terms and provisions herein;
  - b. Must ensure the remote PIC, manipulators of the controls, and VO(s) are informed and familiar with part 107 regulations; and
  - c. Evidence of the above (a and b) must be documented and must be presented for inspection upon request from the Administrator or an authorized representative;
2. **This Waiver may ONLY be used in combination with Operations Waiver 107W-2025-01403 - Expires May 31, 2029.** This Waiver may not be combined with any other waiver(s), authorization(s), or exemption(s) without specific authorization from the FAA;
3. The FAA has the authority to cancel or delay any or all flight operations if the safety of persons or property on the ground or in the air are in jeopardy or there is a violation of the terms of this Waiver;
4. A copy of this Waiver must be accessible and available to the remote PIC at the ground control station during sUA operations that are the subject of this Waiver;
5. The Responsible Person listed on this Waiver must maintain a current list of pilots by name and remote pilot certificate number used in operations under this Waiver. This list must be presented for inspection upon request from the Administrator or an authorized representative;

6. The Responsible Person listed on this Waiver must maintain a current list of sUA by registration number(s) used in operations under this Waiver. This list must be presented for inspection upon request from the Administrator or an authorized representative;
7. For the purposes of this Waiver, direct participants are the remote PICs, persons manipulating the controls, VOs, and any persons whose involvement is necessary for safety of the sUA operation. All other persons are considered non-participants;
8. If a discrepancy exists between the provisions in this Waiver and the waiver application, the Waiver takes precedence and must be followed;

### **Waiver Specific Special Provisions**

9. All Flight Operations under this Waiver must be conducted in accordance with approved Operations Waiver **107W-2025-01403 - Expires May 31, 2029**;
10. NOTAM: The Responsible Person must file a Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) no more than 72 hours and no less than 24 hours prior to operating under this waiver. A NOTAM can be filed by calling 1-877-487-6867 (1-877-4-US-NTMS). The Responsible Person must verify the NOTAM has been issued prior to conducting waived operations;
11. Altitude and Range Operational Parameters: The sUA must not exceed:
  - i. **7000** feet above ground level (AGL); and
  - ii. Must remain within the confines of the defined operational area; and must be conducted using the flight profiles described in this Altitude Waiver application;
12. Prior to commencing operations under this waiver, the Responsible Person must provide a copy of this waiver to the following local entities for their awareness:
  - i. The geographically responsible FAA Flight Standards District Office (FSDO). FSDOs can be located using this web page: [https://www.faa.gov/about/office\\_org/field\\_offices/fsdo](https://www.faa.gov/about/office_org/field_offices/fsdo);
  - ii. Law enforcement (LE) aviation units, agricultural aircraft operators, tour operators, helicopter emergency medical services (HEMS) operators, and other helicopter operators who routinely operate in the local area, and
  - iii. Military representative (MILREP). Use the applicable regional service center email address below:

13. Anti-Collision Lighting: The sUA must be equipped with anti-collision lighting compliant with §107.29 to appropriately increase the conspicuity of the sUA. The anti-collision lighting system must be operational at all times;
14. Operations Area: Operations conducted under this Waiver are limited to the location(s) as described in this Altitude Waiver application;

**OPERATING AREA AND AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL REQUIREMENTS**

15. **Operations Area A & Area B: (Luke Air Force Base Radar Approach Control (LUF RAPCON) Open)** Operations conducted under this Waiver are limited to Class E and G airspace **at or below 2600 feet AGL** in the vicinity of Buckeye, AZ under the jurisdiction of LUF RAPCON as depicted and defined in Attachments 1 - 2.
16. **Operations Area C: (LUF RAPCON Closed)** Operations conducted under this Waiver are limited to Class E and G airspace **at or below 7000 feet AGL** in the vicinity of Buckeye, AZ under the jurisdiction of Albuquerque Air Route Traffic Control Center (ZAB ARTCC) and Phoenix Terminal Radar Approach Control (P50 TRACON) as depicted and defined in Attachments 3 - 4.
17. UAS Operators intending to operate within **Area A, Area B and/or Area C** are required to submit an email notification to the **Airspace Management** org box: [56RMO.ASM.AirSpaceManagement@us.af.mil](mailto:56RMO.ASM.AirSpaceManagement@us.af.mil) no later than two business days prior to the scheduled flight. This notification must provide the following operational details:
- i. Certificate of Waiver (CoW) number
  - ii. Designated Operations Area
  - iii. Planned Altitude
  - iv. Expected Duration of flight
  - v. Pilot in Command (PIC) full name
  - vi. PIC telephone number
18. UAS Operators must contact 56 FW Airspace Management at (623) 856-5855 at least two (2) business days in advance of operating in **Area A, Area B, and/or Area C**.
19. At least sixty (60) minutes prior to conducting operations under this waiver in **Area A and/or Area B**, the UAS Operator must contact LUF RAPCON at (623) 856-7361 to obtain final approval.
20. At least sixty (60) minutes prior to conducting operations under this waiver in **Area C**, the UAS Operator must contact ZAB ARTCC and P50 TRACON to obtain final approval at the following telephone numbers:

21. LUF RAPCON, ZAB ARTCC, and/or P50 TRACON may disapprove, terminate, restrict, or delay UAS flight operations covered by this waiver at any time.

**Operations Area A & Area B:** Operations conducted under this Waiver are limited to Class E and G airspace in the vicinity of Buckeye, AZ as depicted and defined below:

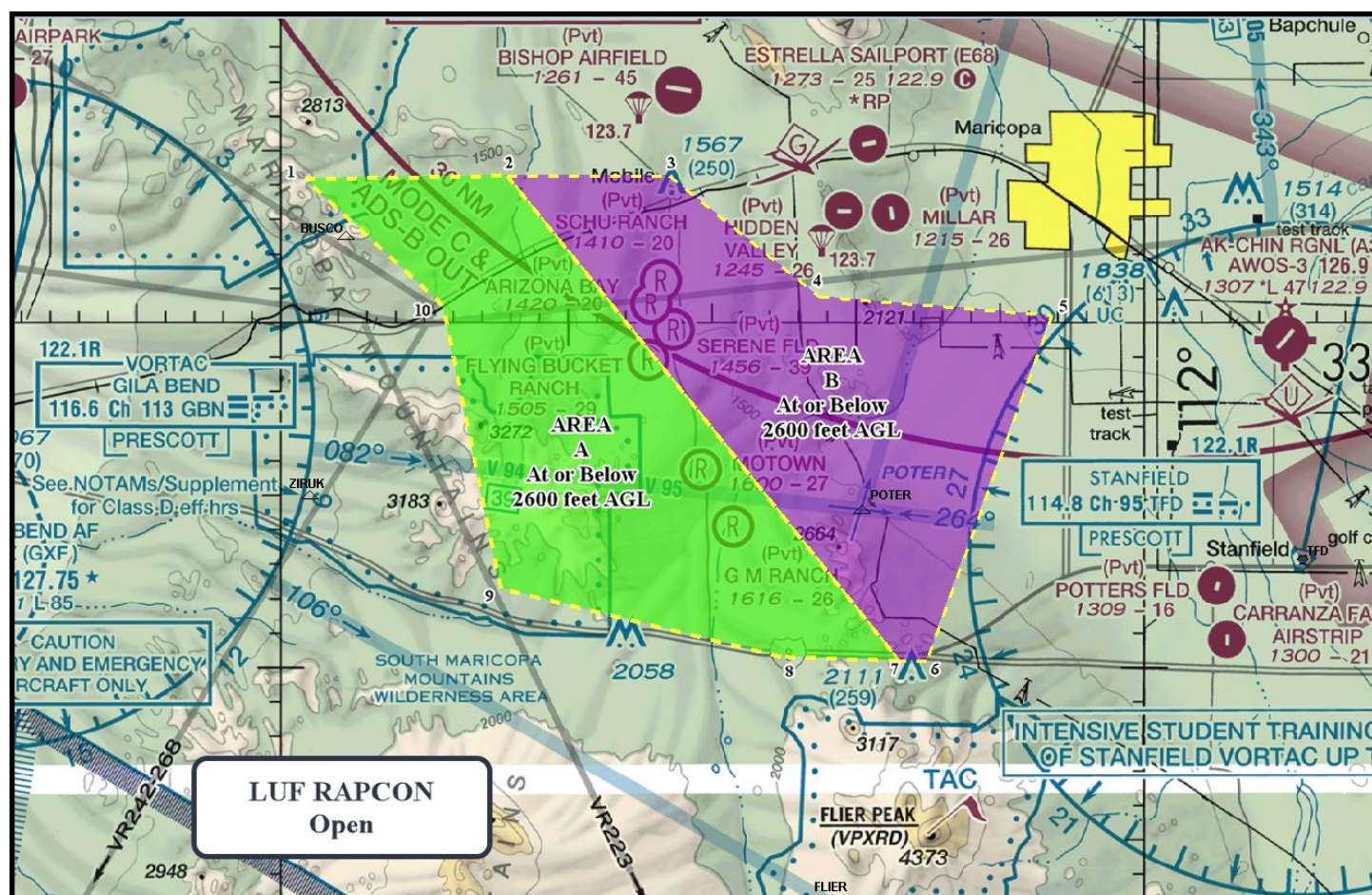

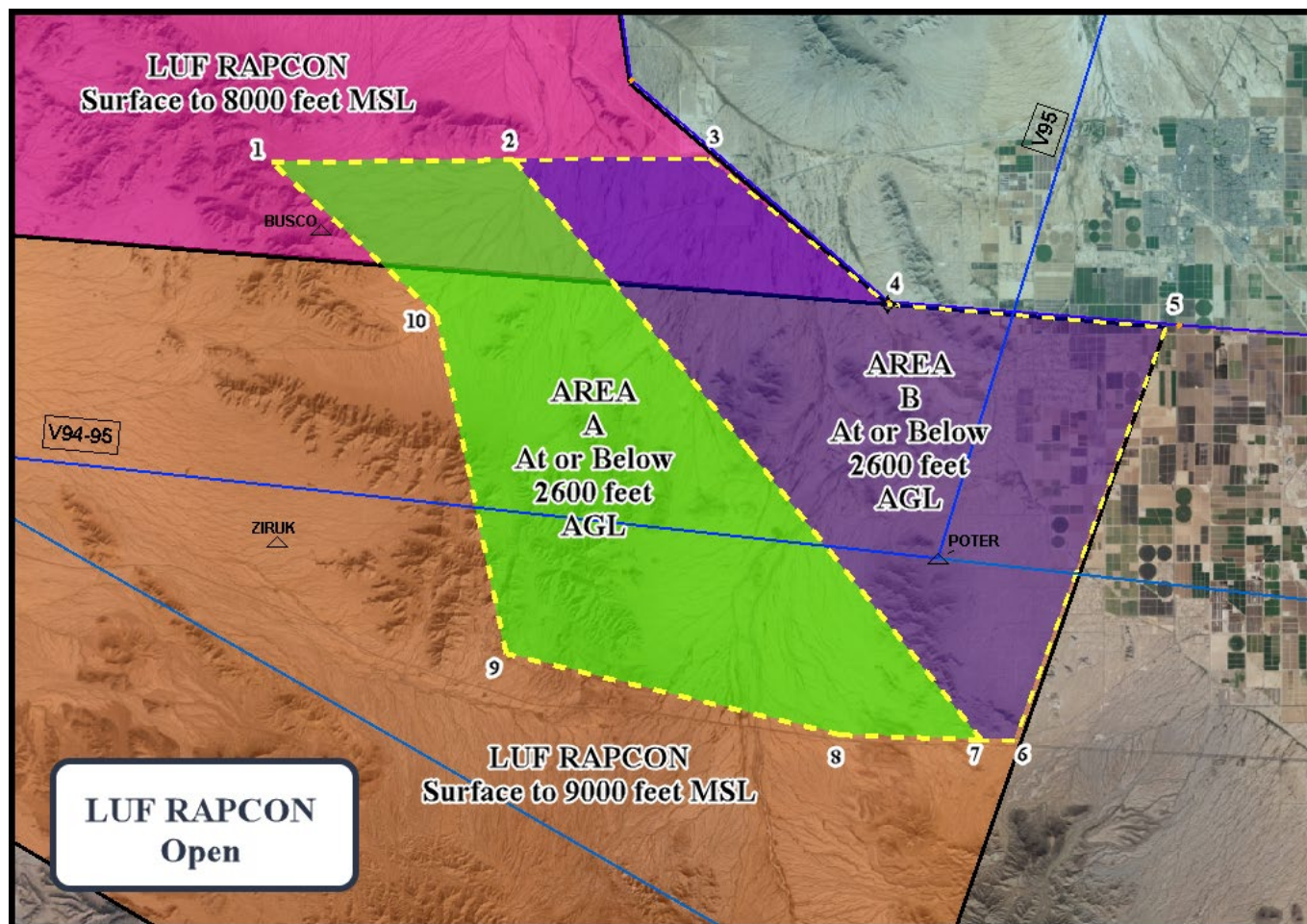

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**UAS Operation above 2600 feet AGL is not authorized in AREA A and AREA B when LUF RAPCON is operational.**



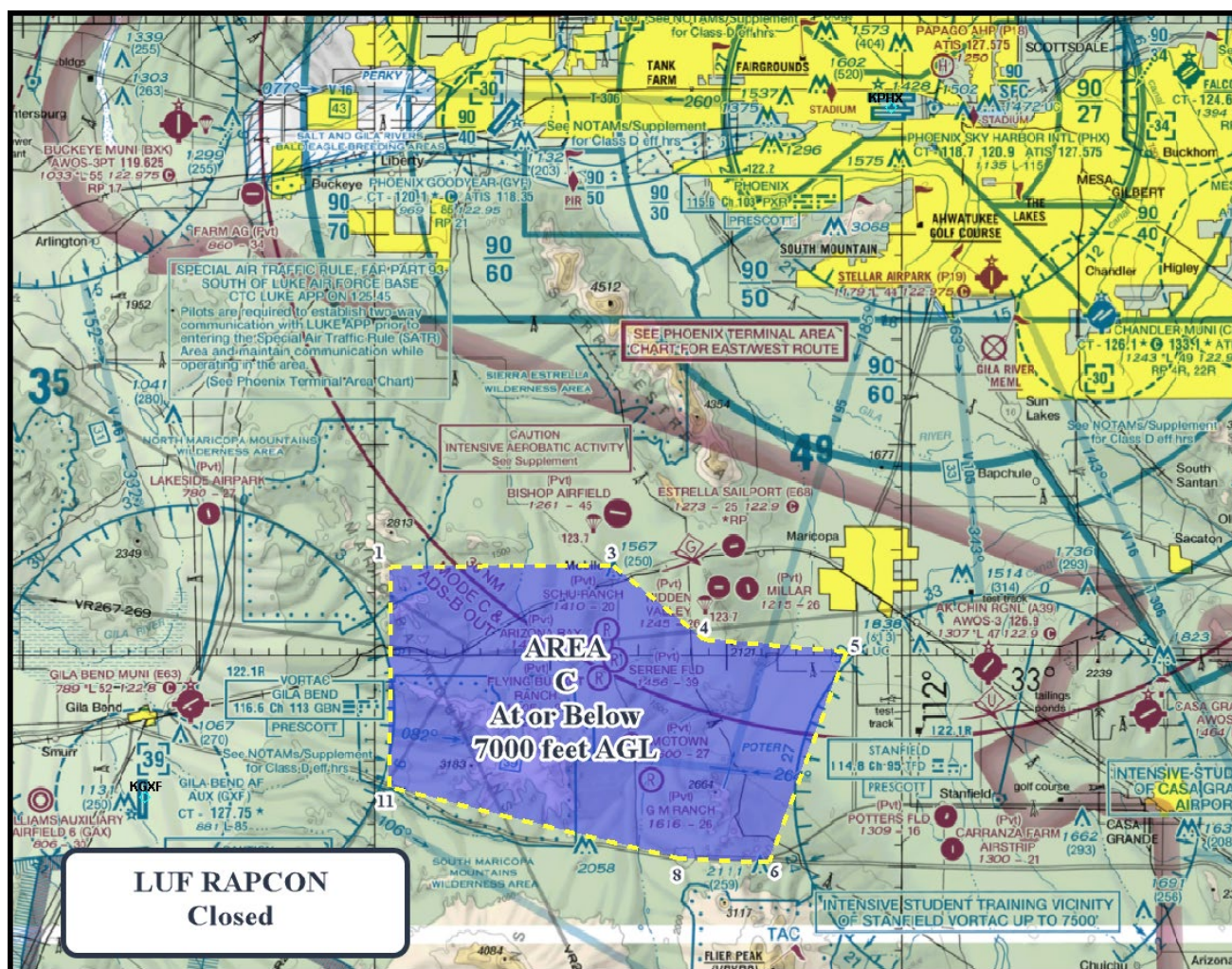
