RqM Definitions

- **What is a requirement?**
 - An unambiguous statement of a capability that a system must provide
 - May be expressed in operational terms
- **What is Requirements Management?**
 - Control system
 - Framework or process
 - Throughout the lifecycle of a program

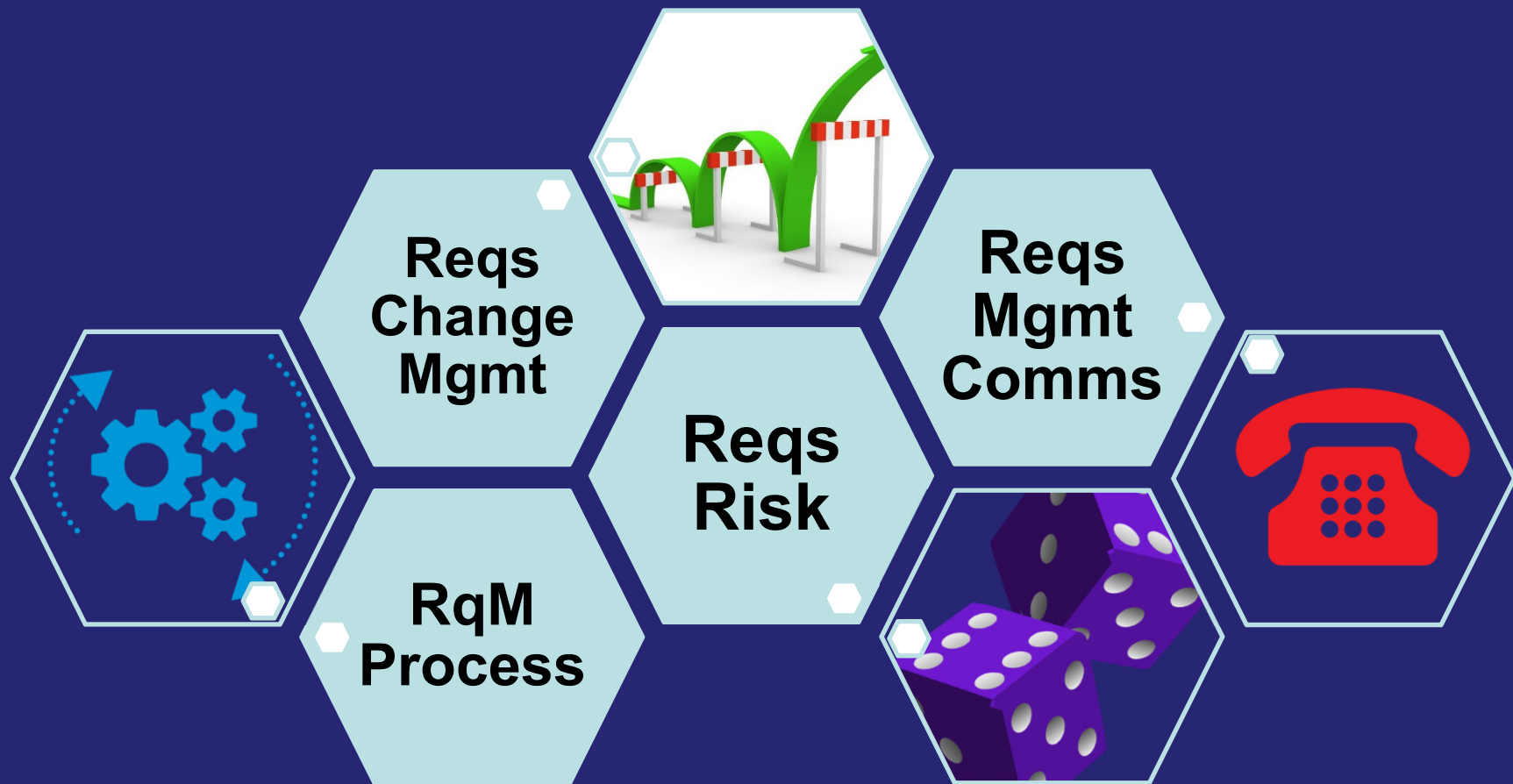

Requirements Management Plans (RqMPs)

APPROVED REQUIREMENTS MANAGEMENT PLANS

 PMO programs are actively engaging in the process of writing and updating their Requirements Management Plans

• 11 approved in 2015
• 8 approved in 2016
• 9 approved in 2017
• 6 approved to date in 2018

REQUIREMENTS MANAGEMENT ASSESSMENTS LAUNCHED IN 2017

Nine assessments have been conducted with Programs with completed Board-approved Requirements Management Plans and are continuing in 2018

• Programs found to be following their plans and shared that they are useful tools in managing requirements, escalations, and stakeholder engagement

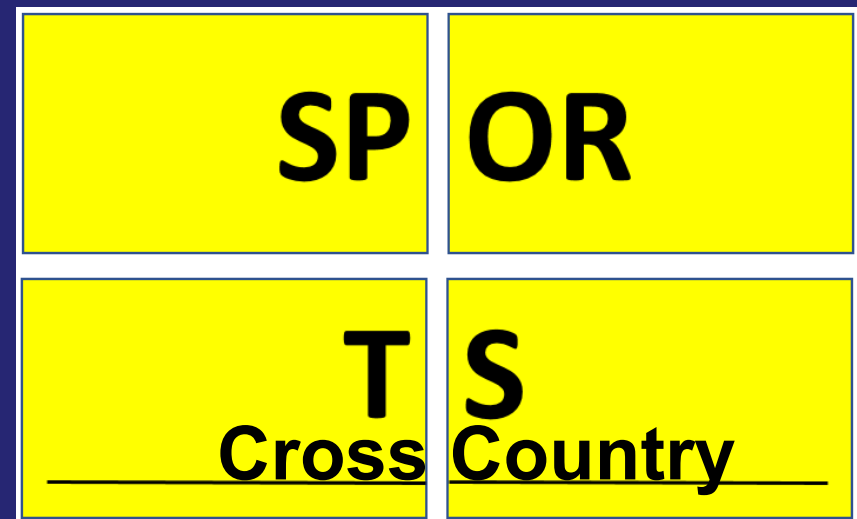
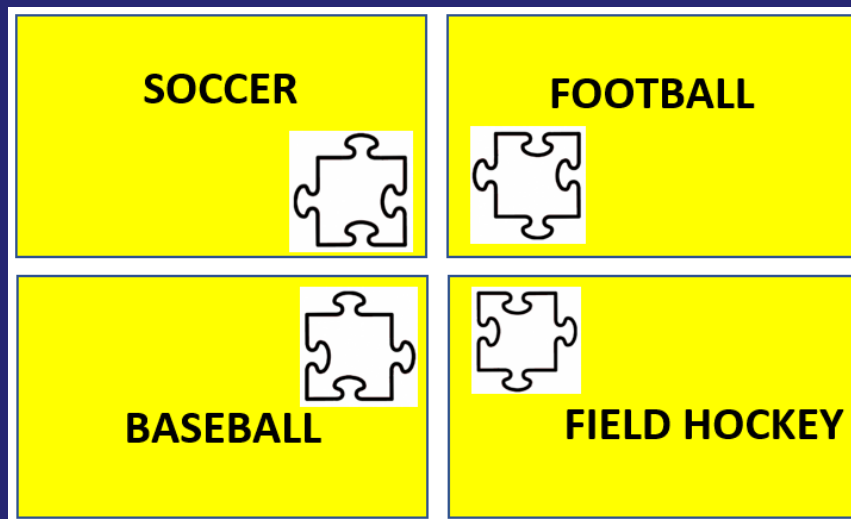
The Systems Thinking / RqM Puzzle
