Dear United States-Instrument Flight Procedure Panel Participants:

FAA Order 8260.59, United States – Instrument Flight Procedures Panel (US-IFPP) paragraph 9 indicates that an FAA manager or Director from the core panel participants is selected for a two year term or upon reassignment. The Flight Standards, Flight Procedures and Airspace Group, Standards section manager is the current chair. The panel has been unable to meet since January 2020 due to the Covid-19 pandemic to elect a new chair.

The organizational structure is being reconsidered and the order is being revised or replaced. In the interim, Flight Standards will retain the chair which is delegated to the Flight Procedures and Airspace Group, Standards Strategy and Execution Lead.
