 - Currently working step 5



Key Aviation Safety R&D Process Steps

- Create, approve, and distribute FY22 Research Proposal Development Guidance
- Develop and Submit proposed research requirements
- Determine the rank order of submitted proposed research requirements
- Develop and review proposed research requirement cost estimates
- Develop and approve portfolio budget proposal
- Develop and Submit Budget Narratives
- Respond to changes (budget, needs, research outputs, etc.)
- Execute research and Transfer research outputs
- Utilize research outputs for Regulations and Standards
- Affect desired Outcomes in the NAS
- Measure and Report on Program (i.e. plans, status, performance, etc.)

- Developed Criterion aligned with AVSMT Direction
 - Safety
 - High, Moderate, and None (with supporting evidence)
 - Legislative Direction
 - Mandatory, Discretionary, and None (with supporting evidence)
 - Administration Direction (other than the external checklist documents)
 - Memo or None (with supporting evidence)
 - Administrators Commitments
 - Documented Commitments or None (with supporting evidence)
 - Regulatory Impact
 - Impact on Regulations, Standards/Policy/Guidance, or None (with supporting evidence)



FY2022 Draft AVS RE&D Portfolio Development Process

How the RED Management Team got here:

- Developed Rank Order Scoring and Ranking Methodology
 - Applied criteria with each of 7 offices independently scored the 78 proposals and
 - Determined initial relative rank order of the 78 proposals based on composite score calculated from all 7 score sets
 - Applied new grouping process to develop Rank Order
 - Group 1 Legislative Direction (mandatory)
 - Group 2 Core Responsibilities
 - Group 3a Remaining Mission Critical
 - Group 3b Remaining Proposals
 - Applied new process allowing each office to "adjust" individual proposals position within the group they ended up in

FY2022 Draft AVS RE&D Portfolio Development Process How the RED Management Team got here:

- Developed Portfolio Budget Proposal
 - Applied new process for Performing organizations to offer integrated budget proposals
 - Obtained the FY22 contract funding target from Finance (\$34.8M)
 - Developed 2 optional budget scenarios under the target for AVSMT to consider
 - AVSMT chose the option (Mendoza Line) shown in the SAS Report we will go through tomorrow
