

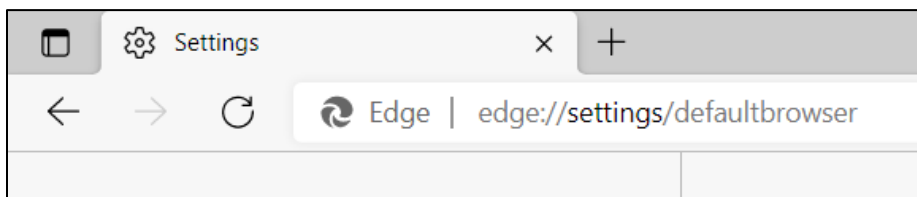
How to Configure your Windows 10 PC for WebOPSS

These instructions are for Industry users who access WebOPSS from outside the FAA network. These steps must be completed, in their entirety, to ensure WebOPSS will load properly after Microsoft disables IE11 on/about June 15, 2022.

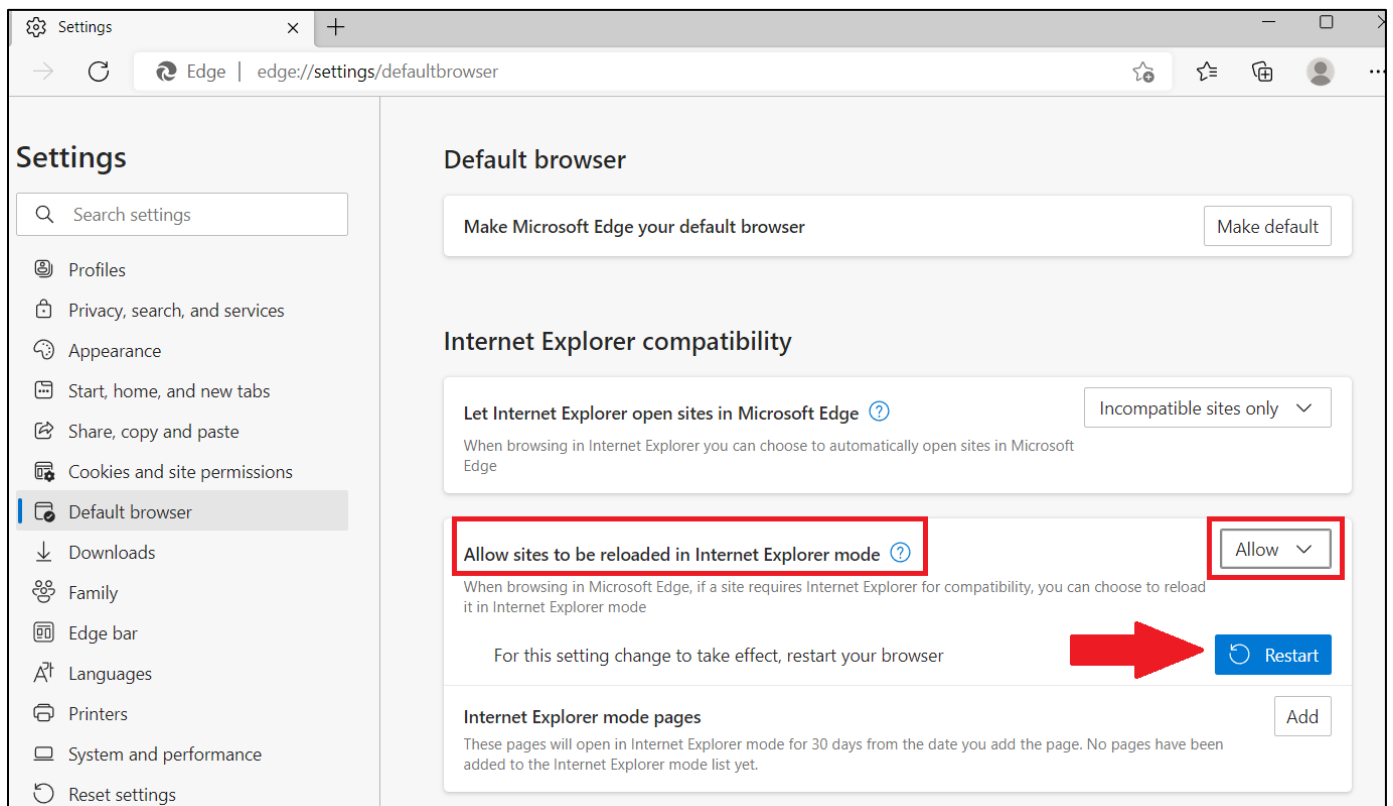
DO NOT uninstall IE11 or you will lose the ability to use WebOPSS!

IE11 must remain installed on your Windows 10 PC for IE Mode to be available within Edge.

1. Open **Microsoft Edge** on a **Windows 10 PC**
2. In the address bar **type** (or copy/paste) **edge://settings/defaultbrowser** and hit **Enter**



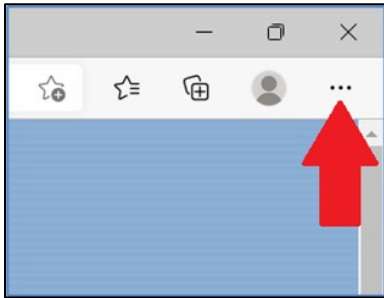
3. Under **Internet Explorer compatibility** > **Allow sites to be reloaded in Internet Explorer mode**, select **“Allow”** from the drop-down
 - If **“Allow”** is greyed out and/or the top of the page states, “Your browser is managed by your organization” **contact your IT Department for assistance**



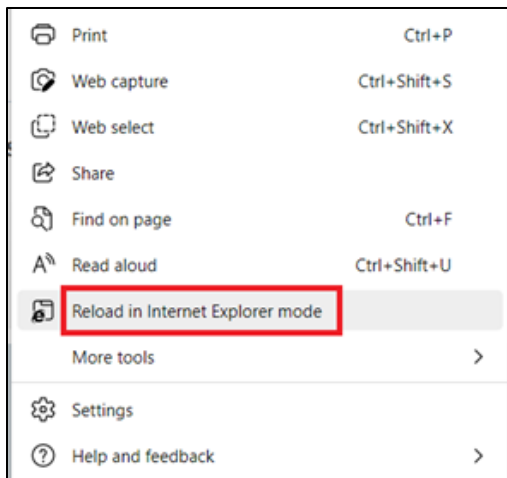
4. Click **Restart**. If you do not see a Restart button, **completely close MS edge**

5. Navigate to **https://webopss.faa.gov** in Microsoft Edge. **Login**

6. Click the three dots in the upper right corner of the browser



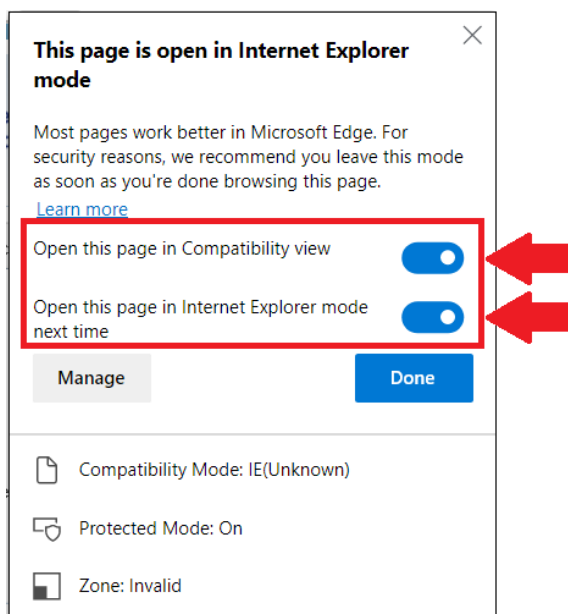
7. Select **Reload in Internet Explorer mode**



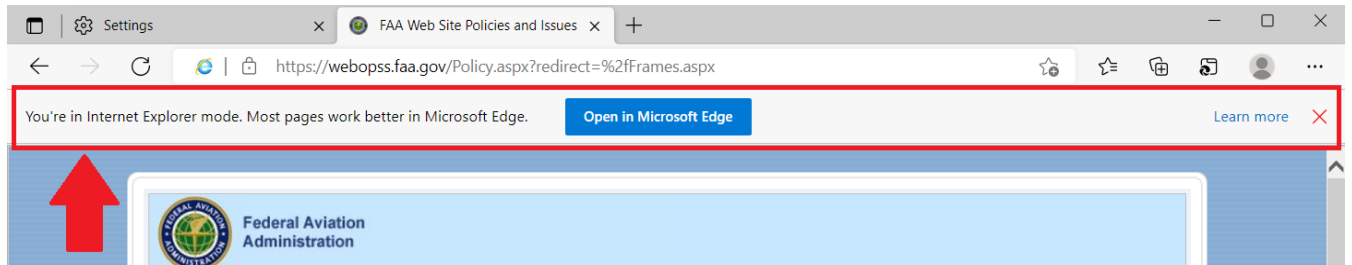
8. When prompted, **re-enter** your login credentials

9. **Toggle BOTH** selections **ON** to “Open this page in Compatibility view” and “Open this page in Internet Explorer mode next time” then click **Done**

➤ **This setting remains for 30 days and then you will need to repeat Steps #1-9**

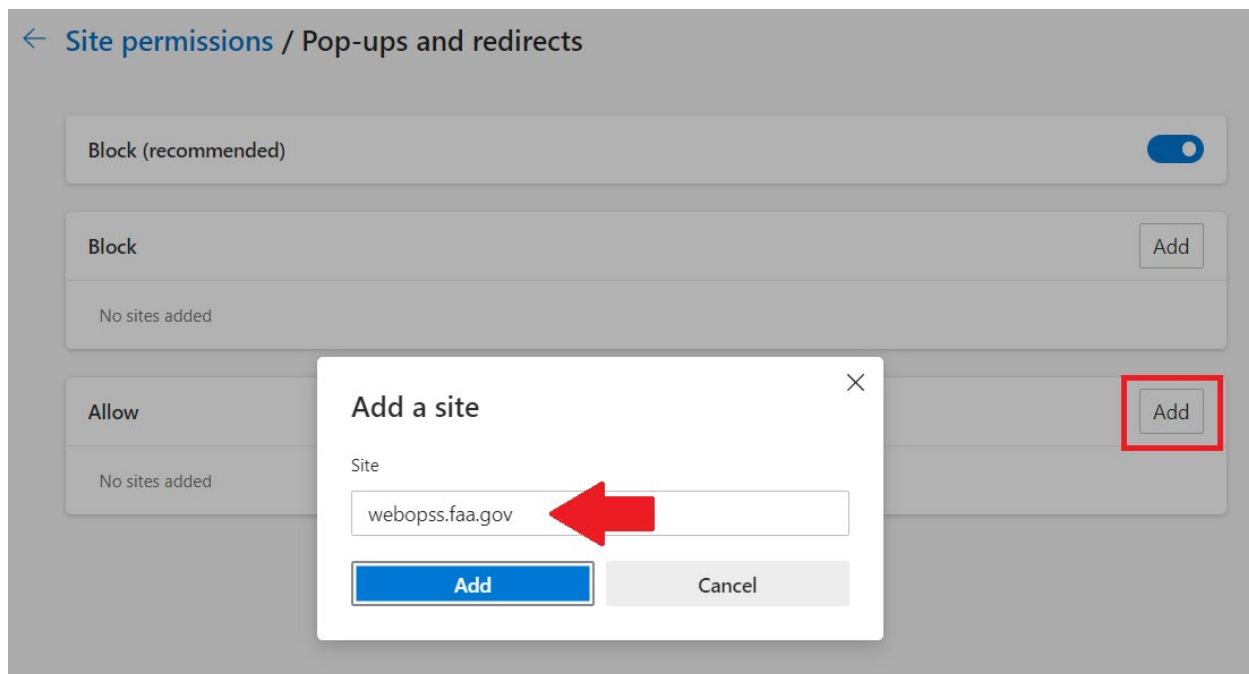


10. To confirm IE mode, ensure you see the **IE mode bar**, shown below



We also recommend turning off the pop-up blocker within Edge for WebOPSS:

1. In the address bar, type (or copy/paste) **edge://settings/content/popups** and hit **Enter**
2. Under **Allow**, click the **ADD** button
3. **Type** webopss.faa.gov and click **ADD**
