Dear Captain Renk:

Thank you and the Performance-based Operations Aviation Rulemaking Committee (PARC) for your recommendation on Standards for Implementation of Required Navigation Performance Approach (RNP APCH) procedures with Extended Visual Segment, which we received February 3, 2021.

The Flight Technologies and Procedures Division (AFS-400) is reviewing the recommendation and you'll find our Action Plan attached that summarizes our continued support for the PARC's Recommendation.

As with all changes to the National Airspace System (NAS), we intend to engage our Safety Management System processes to evaluate the changes specified in the Recommendation to ensure we have appropriate mitigations in place as part of our Action Plan. These steps should not have an appreciable effect on the intent of the Recommendation, but are intended to ensure no new hazards are introduced into our NAS as a result of accepting the Recommendation.
