SCDS Service Access Agreement

Summary Up Front

- The SCDS Service Access Agreement (SAA) has been updated to include new FAA SWIM Governance that will take effect June 1
- SCDS Users need to re-sign their SAAs NLT May 31
- Signing a subscription's SAA automatically enables data compression

New SWIM Governance

- Updated SWIM Governance
 - "Non-NAS Impacting Usage Only"
 - SCDS Data Usage
 - Internal Distribution
 - Data Compression


- The SCDS Service Access Agreement (SAA) has been updated to reflect new governance standards
 - All new subscriptions will use this updated version
 - Existing users need to re-sign this new SAA for each one of their subscriptions

Re-Signing SAAs

- SAA Re-signing window is March 25- May 31
 - The new SAA will be released and available for re-signing on March 25
 - Existing subscriptions that do not have updated SAAs by June 1, 2024 will be disabled
- Users will receive reminder emails before May 31

Re-Signing SAAs (cont.)

Directions will be provided within the SWIFT Portal



Other SAA Things to Know

Annual Updates

- SAAs are valid for one year, and users are required to update them annually
- Users will receive system-generated email reminders 60 and 30 days before expiration
- Complete this process before the deadline to avoid disruptions in SWIM data services

Access Revocation

- If the SAA is not renewed by its expiration date each year, the associated subscription will be disabled
- If the SAA is not renewed within 60 days of disabling, the subscription will be permanently deleted

Compression is Required!

- Compressed data connections are now mandatory
 - Consuming compressed data is the only authorized method for obtaining SCDS data
 - Data compression reduces SCDS operational cost by reducing internet bandwidth needs
 - It is Users' responsibility to keep data compression enabled
- Re-signing the SAA will enable compression automatically if currently disabled

Am I Already Using Compression?

- Subscriptions provisioned after 2021 were created with compression enabled
 - 86% of current users are using compression
 - If you did not manually disable compression it is still enabled
- The SCDS Team will reach out to Users not using compression
 - Moving to compression may require a plan

Planning for Compression

Compression creates higher resource usage

- For low data consumers, this increase will be almost imperceptible
- Large data consumers may notice an increase in resource utilization

Possible mitigations

- Increasing/adding physical or virtual CPU power to improve decompression speeds
- Adopting a compression-supported messaging API
- Adding additional consumer clients to distribute resource usage

Necessary User Actions

If compression is currently enabled

Re-sign SAAs between March 25 and May 31

If compression is NOT currently enabled

- You will be notified
- Identify and plan for increased resource usage if needed
- Re-sign SAAs between March 25 and May 31



Other SCDS Updates

Maintenance Events Notifications

- NASEO will begin providing maintenance event details via the SWIFT Portal
 - Includes planned and unplanned service outages
- Users will be able to create notifications for specific services
- The ability to set User preferences will be available March 25
 - Users are encouraged to set up desired notifications then
 - Notifications can be delivered via email, the SWIFT Portal, or both
- Users will be informed when operational notifications will start.

Maintenance Events Notifications (cont.)



LADD Requirements Reminder

- The Limiting Aircraft Data Displayed (LADD)
 program implements federal requirements
 to provide aircraft owners the ability to have
 their flight data filtered from SWIM
 distribution or public display
- Users who publicly display data obtained from SWIM are required to apply the LADD filter per the SCDS Service Access Agreement
 - Research and other non-public use cases are not subject to LADD requirements

FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018

Section 566, Right to Privacy When Using Air Traffic Control System


The Administrator shall, upon request of a private aircraft owner or operator, block the registration number of the aircraft from any public dissemination or display, except in data made available to a Government agency, for the noncommercial flights of the owner or operator.

LADD Requirements Reminder (cont.)

- The FAA LADD program office distributes a weekly LADD filter file update on Tuesdays before 12pm EST
 - The LADD list represents those private aircraft owners or operators who have requested privacy on publicly viewable products or services
 - Users must scrub this data from their own data prior to public release

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NAS Service Registry and Repository (NSRR)

NSRR Two-Factor Authentication

- Two-Factor Authentication (TFA) is required for all NSRR users by March 31, 2024
 - System will be inaccessible without TFA
- Users will perform a one-time configuration of TFA then use the two-step process at each login


Two-step Login Process

Existing username and password

One-time code from an authentication application

NSRR Two-Factor Authentication (cont.)

Implementation – One time configuration




Supported Authenticators:

- Microsoft Authenticator (mobile)
- Google Authenticator (mobile)
- GAuth Web Application (desktop)

NSRR Two-Factor Authentication (cont.)

Implementation – Second step now required after every login





NSRR Two-Factor Authentication (cont.)


