SCDS By The Numbers

- As of July 2024, roughly all SCDS users with active subscriptions have re-signed SAAs
- We've had a 26% increase in subscription users since December 2023
- Since enabling compression, SCDS has reduced data egress costs by roughly 26% per user, and 7% per subscription







SCDS Standards Revisited

Data Compression

 Consuming compressed data is the only authorized method for obtaining SCDS data products.

JMS-as-Standard


- Users are advised to access SCDS data products using JMS based consumer applications.
- Other consumer applications are not supported by SCDS helpdesk

Internal Redistribution

 Users are required to internally distribute SCDS data products within their organization vs. requesting/maintaining duplicate subscriptions.

Enforcement Efforts

- The SCDS team will be monitoring and reviewing accounts and subscriptions to ensure adherence to new standards.
- Owners of accounts or subscriptions not adhering to standards will be contacted before any actions are taken.
- Users can submit an SCDS Guideline Exemption Request if necessary
 - Requests will be reviewed systematically.




SWIFT Portal Beyond Subscriptions




More Than Just Subscriptions!

- All SWIM Users, regardless of connection type, can benefit from Portal capabilities:




SWIFT Portal Capability: Discovery

- Full product list with service description
- Links to the NSRR for service documentation
 - Note: Requires an active NSRR account




SWIFT Portal Capability: Status

- Displays availability of products and services
 - NEMS/NESG users can request NEMS node status access from the SCDS Support Team
- View Details displays a
 histogram of service
 statuses from a given site
 (SCDS, ATL, OEX, etc.) and
 an incident log of service
 maintenance or disruptions




SWIFT Portal Capability: Maintenance

- Displays active and upcoming maintenance events
 - Past events are also viewable
- Notifications can be set up for most SWIM services and respective sites
- Currently undergoing enhancements



SWIFT Portal Capability: Community

- Channels for specific products or data services help users connect and collaborate on common interests
 - Discussions can be broader than SCDS

CSS-FD is the set of services that will deliver enhanced flight data management, flight planning and flight plan filing in accordance with ICAO global standards (DOC 9965 – Manual on Flight and Flow – Information for a Collaborative Environment (FF-ICE)).

- CSS-FD is a cornerstone for the info-centric National Airspace System (NAS) and supports Performance Based
 Operations (PBO)
- CSS-FD and FF-ICE will enable the harmonization between operators and Air Service Providers (ASPs) across the globe
- · CSS-FD establishes a standards-based flight planning and filing environment and enhances collaborative decision


