It is designed to support the DPRE in maintaining their designation with the knowledge necessary to carry out the duties of their designation and continue to successfully represent the FAA Administrator. To enroll in the Initial Designated Parachute Rigger Examiner (IDPRE) training, prospective DPRE applicants must meet all applicable policy requirements referenced (in part) from FAA Order 8000.95:

- Volume 1, Chapter 7: Training
- Volume 5, Chapter 3: Selection and Evaluation of a Designee Applicant
- Volume 5, Chapter 4: Designee Appointment
- Volume 5, Chapter 7: Training

If you are eligible to attend and have successfully registered and paid for the course, you will receive a welcome letter with class delivery details.
