(S) Authorized by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to develop and maintain non-Part 97 (special) satellite-based performance-based navigation (PBN) instrument flight procedures (IFP) for fixed-wing IFPs.

(PEP) Procedure Evaluation Pilot (PEP)—An Individual associated with certain non-FAA service providers who hold a PEP Letter of Authorization (LOA) issued by the Flight Technologies and Procedures Division. This LOA authorizes procedure-specific onsite evaluation of the landing location for certain helicopter Instrument Flight Procedures (IFP).
