**Background:** This guidance waives specific requirements in FAA Order 8260.19I paragraph for all service providers.

**Purpose:** The intent of this memo is to waive the 14 CFR Part 139 airport exception for obtaining airspace analysis on special IAPs (arrival, departure, holding and enroute) submitted for consideration for controlled airspace in accordance with Order 7400.2 (see paragraph 17-1-3 [Class D], or paragraph 18-1-3 [Class E] and or other applicable airspace chapters).

- 1. FAA Order 8260.19I paragraphs 4-1-3.a and 4-1-3.e are waived to eliminate exception to airspace requirements at part 139 airports for special procedures.
- 2. FAA Order 8260.19I paragraph 5-2-1 is waived to remove the reference to paragraph 4-1-3.e for special procedures.
