What is it?

The SAS External Portal is a free, secure, web-based application that allows direct communication between Certificate Holders and Applicants and the FAA.

Benefits to Applicants?

It allows you to:

- ✓ Manage Preapplication Information
- ✓ Provide details on the types of programs you want to perform
- ✓ View, complete, and submit scoped Element Design Data Collection Tools
- ✓ Submit and manage information and receive feedback
