Subject: Waiver to FAA Order 8260.3E, Additional Information for Simultaneous Independent Approaches Spaced at Least 4300 Feet Apart

This memorandum authorizes a waiver to FAA Order 8260.3E, United States Standard for Terminal Instrument Procedures (TERPS), Appendix E, Section 2, Paragraph 6d that requires either (GPS) be included in the procedure title or "GPS REQUIRED" charted on the procedure. GPS is mandated by the enabling studies, but charting requirements are now satisfied by FAA Order 8260.19I, Flight Procedures and Airspace, paragraph 8-6-8, policy for PBN requirements box.
