Examples of Agricultural Aircraft Demonstration Special Provisions.

As appropriate, in addition to the applicable special provisions in paragraph A, include the following special provisions/restrictions for events that will use agricultural aircraft demonstrations.

E. Agricultural Aircraft Demonstration Special Provisions

- 1. No pilot shall perform any agricultural aircraft demonstration unless they comply with the provisions of 14 CFR § 137.53(a) and (b).
- 2. The aircraft must meet the provisions of § 137.53(c).
- 3. All pull-up and turn-around maneuvers shall be initiated in a direction other than toward the primary spectator area.
- 4. Only water will be dispensed. The demonstration shall be conducted on or beyond the Category III show line and in a manner as to prevent the dispensed water from drifting into the primary spectator area.
- 5. Aircraft and equipment used for the agricultural aircraft demonstration shall be thoroughly cleansed prior to the flight demonstration and/or public static display so as to be free of any poisons or other chemicals.
- 6. Aircraft used for conducting agricultural aircraft demonstrations shall not conduct maneuvers when the pitch angle exceeds a positive or negative 60° angle from the horizon, and/or when the bank angle exceeds 75°, or as limited by the appropriate aircraft flight manual.
