

Examples of Agricultural Aircraft Demonstration Special Provisions.

As appropriate, in addition to the applicable special provisions in paragraph A, include the following special provisions/restrictions for events that will use agricultural aircraft demonstrations.

E. Agricultural Aircraft Demonstration Special Provisions

1. No pilot shall perform any agricultural aircraft demonstration unless they comply with the provisions of 14 CFR § 137.53(a) and (b).
2. The aircraft must meet the provisions of § 137.53(c).
3. All pull-up and turn-around maneuvers shall be initiated in a direction other than toward the primary spectator area.
4. Only water will be dispensed. The demonstration shall be conducted on or beyond the Category III show line and in a manner as to prevent the dispensed water from drifting into the primary spectator area.
5. Aircraft and equipment used for the agricultural aircraft demonstration shall be thoroughly cleansed prior to the flight demonstration and/or public static display so as to be free of any poisons or other chemicals.
6. Aircraft used for conducting agricultural aircraft demonstrations shall not conduct maneuvers when the pitch angle exceeds a positive or negative 60° angle from the horizon, and/or when the bank angle exceeds 75°, or as limited by the appropriate aircraft flight manual.
