Are You Conducting Self-Evaluations of Your Airport's Accessible Communication Programs, Services and Activities?

# Are Self-Evaluations Required?

- **Yes, Airport Operators are required to conduct Self-Evaluations.**
- Airport Operators are required to ensure compliance of its services, policies, and practices with applicable regulations (28 CFR § 35.105; 49 CFR § 27.11(c)(2) and (3)); and required to establish a system for periodically reviewing and updating the evaluation per 49 CFR § 27.11(c)(2)(v).

# Are You In Compliance?

- Are you conducting Self-Evaluations of your airport's Accessible communication systems and programs?
- Are you instituting a recurring, periodic self evaluation of your airport's Accessible communication programs and activities? Are you maintaining records of the scope and frequency of such self-evaluations?

# Accessible Communication

- Is Your Electronic Communication Accessible to the Public?
- Is Your Airport's website Accessible?
- Is Your Flight Information Display System Accessible?
- Is Your ADA/504 Coordinator's Contact Information Accessible?
