

COVID-19

Situation in Iceland:

- 14-day incidence per 100.000 inhabitants is 124
- Vaccination in Iceland;
 - All citizens 12 years and older 89% vaccination.
 - Air traffic controllers and support staff: 100% vaccination
- Border restriction in Iceland;
 - Foreign passengers: Full vaccination certificate (or certificate of previous infection), preregistration, negative PCR or rapid antigen test
 - Those who live in Iceland must undergo a Covid-19 test within 48 hours as well.



NORTH ATLANTIC - NEW ENTRANTS

New Entrant Readiness Project Team (NER PT)

 The objective of the project team is to ensure a consistent method of managing the integration of new entrants with established commercial operation in NAT airspace.

- The outcome of NER PT is to;
 - draft guidance to assist those planning activities in NAT airspace, and
 - propose to the NAT SPG on how its structure or work program might be amended to govern these requests as part of its routine task.

 An eruption has been ongoing in Geldingadalur since March 19th, 2021








VOLCANIC ACTIVITY IN ICELAND

- Askja´s Aviation Colour Code was changed to YELLOW on September 3rd, 2021.





VOLCEX21

- VOLCEX21 will be held November 16th, 2021.
 - VOLCEX21 will exercise a volcano eruption of Eyjafjallajökull
- Aim is to demonstrate the lessons learnt since 2010 and assess the impact to international aviation in the current environment using the current ICAO provisions and contingency plan.
- A VOLCEX21 workshop will be held in Reykjavik on October 5.-6. and will be a hybrid event.
