SD Awareness In-Flight Training

SD Demonstration Flight (Background) -

Based on the British Model. Introduced to U.S. Army by COL M. G. Braithwaite.





- TUSAARL assessment conducted.
 - Same basic maneuvers (UH-1 vs. Gazelle).
 - Flight Surgeon in a pilot seat or in the cabin.





SD Awareness In-Flight Training

SD Demonstration Flight (Background) - (cont.)

- Assessment determined that Demo Flights were an excellent augmentation to the academic training.
- SD Demo Flights integrated into IERW syllabus in September 1997.
- SD Demo Flights ended May 1999 because of:





SD Awareness In-Flight Training

SD Demonstration Flight (Background) - (cont.)







US Army SD Demonstration Flight

Challenges Encountered:

- Difference in US & British Flight Surgeon duties.
- Critical shortage of US Flight Surgeons.
- TUH-1 is being phased out.
- Shortage of UH-1 pilots. (USAAVNC/Flatiron)





US Army SD Demonstration Flight

Challenges Encountered (cont.):

TERW syllabus problems. (no makeup day)

Contractor lost a day (2 hrs) of a/c training.

RESULT: Pressure to cancel the SD Demo Flight or use the TH-67 as the aircraft.





So, what's so bad about using the TH-67?

- Limited to 3 on board. (One IP and two students.)
- Eliminates the Flight Surgeon.
- The IP must be trained to teach physiological

limitations and all training must be standar







US Army SD Demonstration Flight

- USAARL & USASAM concerned over possible elimination of SD Demo Flights.
- Aviation Training Brigade did not want to eliminate Demo Flights, but had few options.
- Convened meeting of all concerned USAARL, USASAM, ATB, USASC and others.





US Army SD Demonstration Flight

Meeting Outcome:

- 1. All agreed training was important.
- 2. UH-1/ UH60 could not be used.
- 3. Only option was to use TH-67 & IP's to continue SD Demo Flights.
- 4. In order to keep training in syllabus, requirement for Flight Surgeon must be eliminated.





Meeting Outcome (cont.):

5. USAARL agreed to

- Training has started in TH-67 / IP's as trainers.
- Training is part of syllabus and, thus, mandatory.
- Allows training day flexibility.
- Tury's out on effectiveness.

- Background (COL Braithwaite)
- Recreate events and conditions of actual SD accidents
- **USAARL** Study
- **USAARL** Report No. 98-17 (18 scenarios)





Graduate (Continuation) Rotary Wing In-Flight Training

SD Scenarios can be used in any visual flight simulators if modified.







Raise awareness of SD & those factors which make SD more likely to occur.





- Scenarios demonstrated to:
 - **Division Commander's Courses (G.O.)**
 - Aviation Pre-Command Course (LTC & COL)
 - TVIP's
- TUSAARL has trained trainers worldwide.
- Active Duty Use is voluntary in ATP
- NG EAATS mandatory for IP's
- NG WAATS used in refresher training
