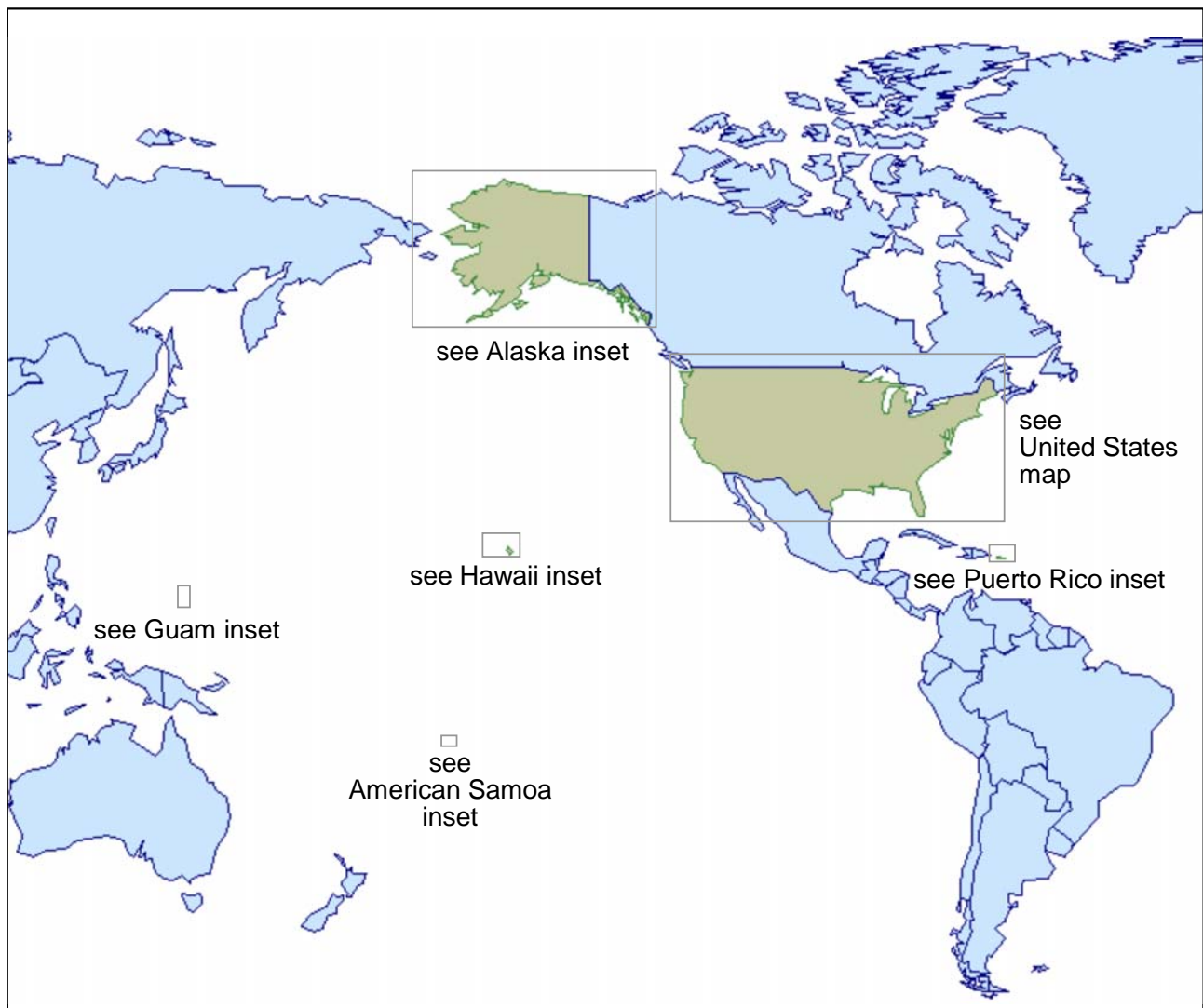


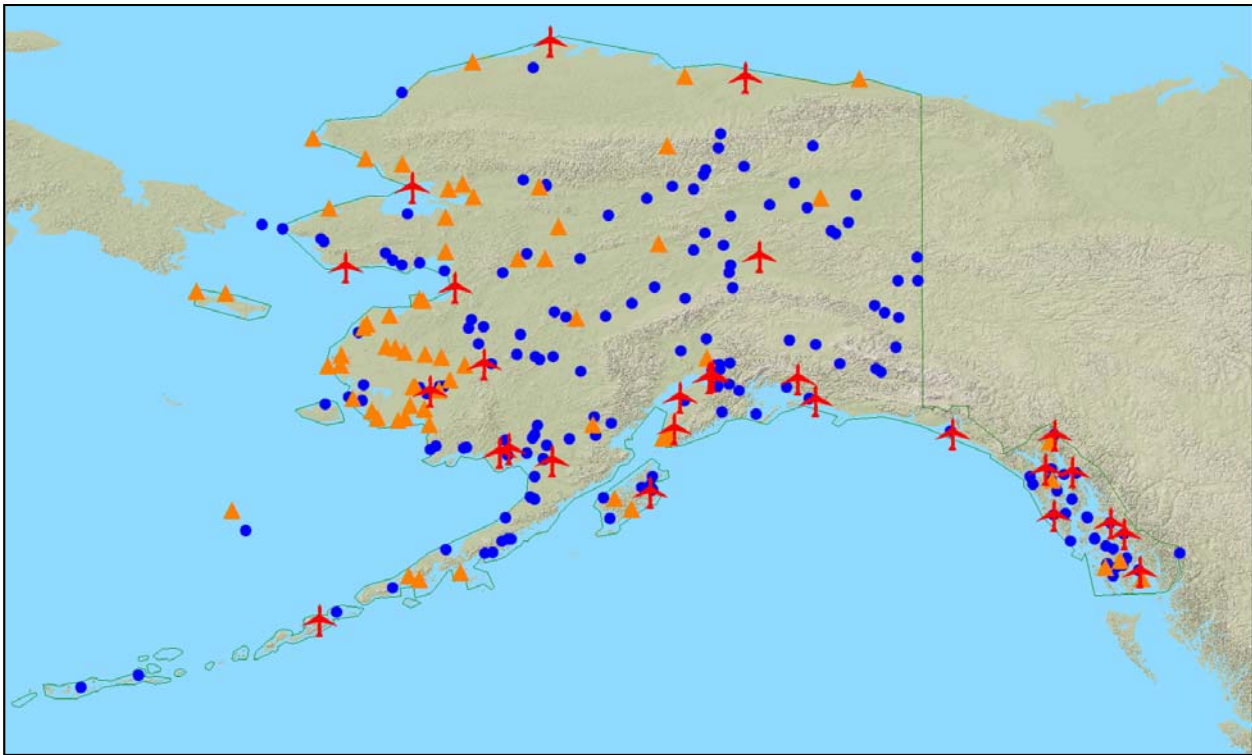

EXPLANATION OF MAPS IN APPENDIX B

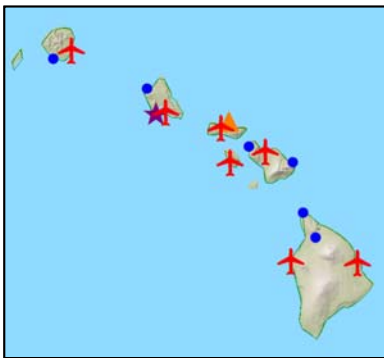

Insert maps of all 3,380 NPIAS airports, as delineated below, are shown on the following pages.

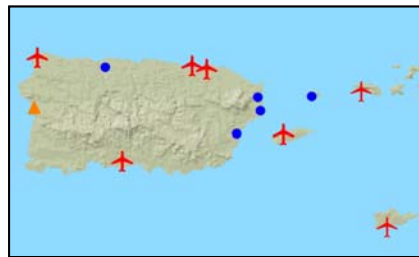

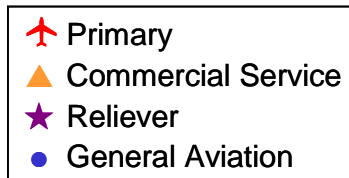

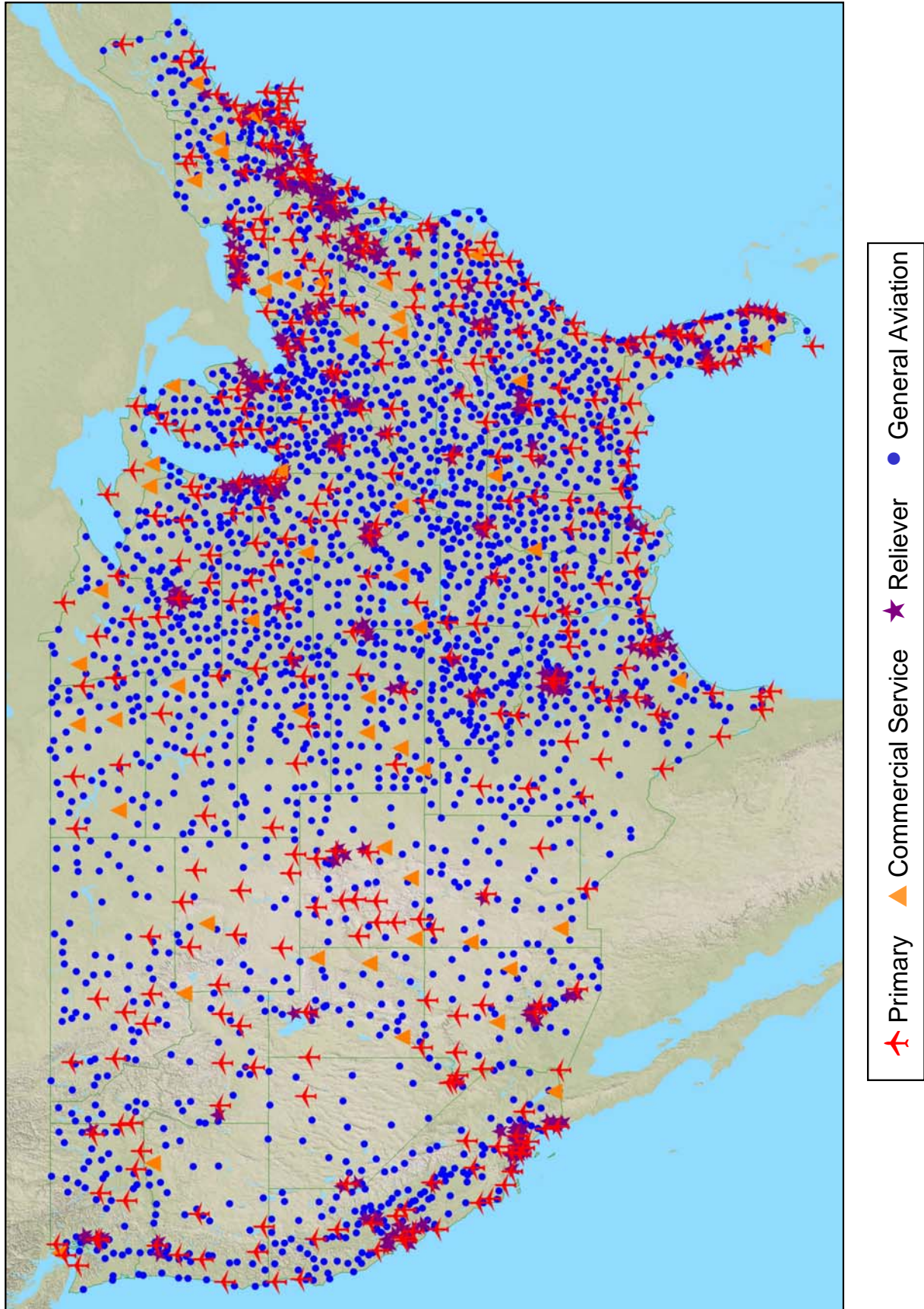

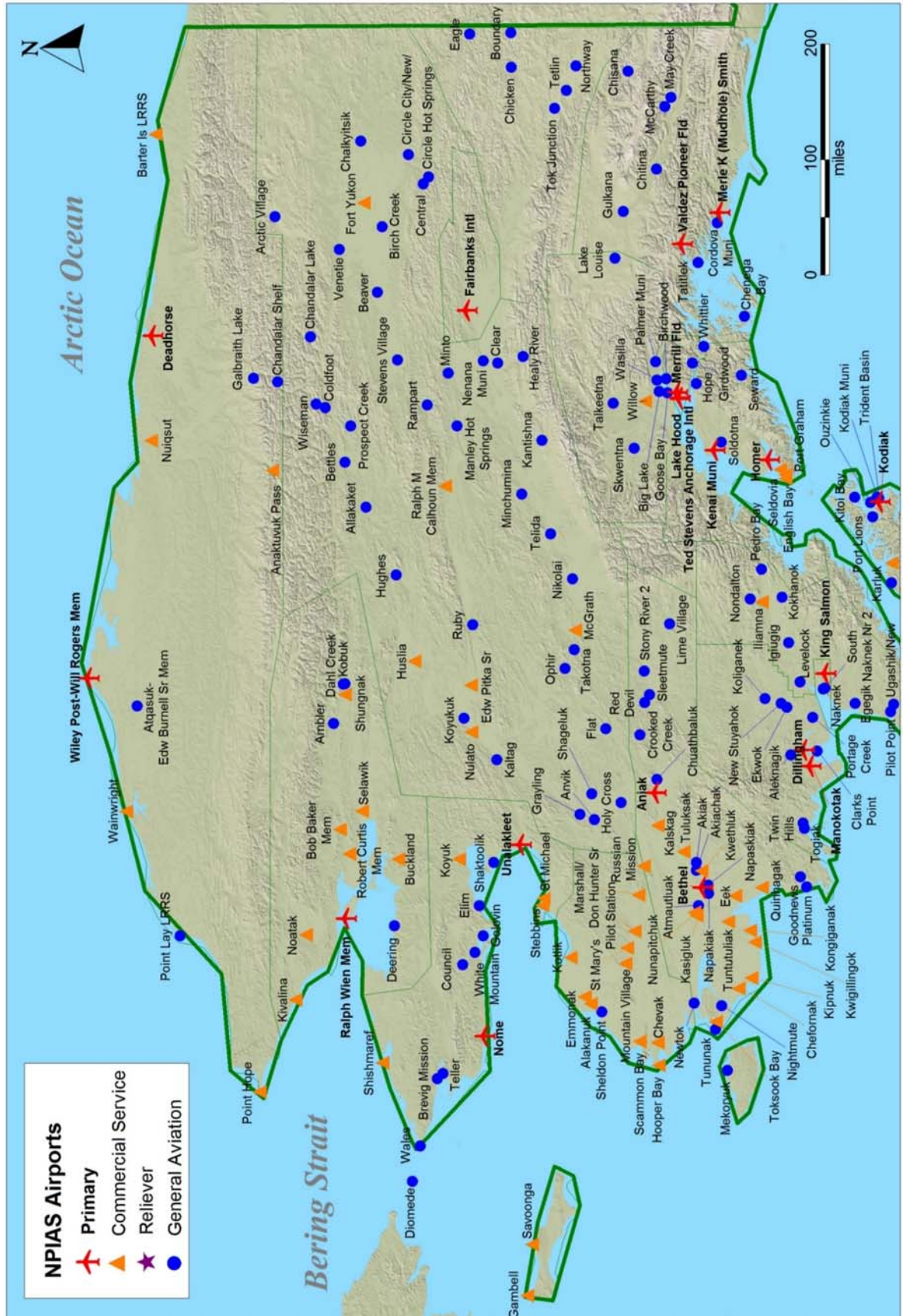

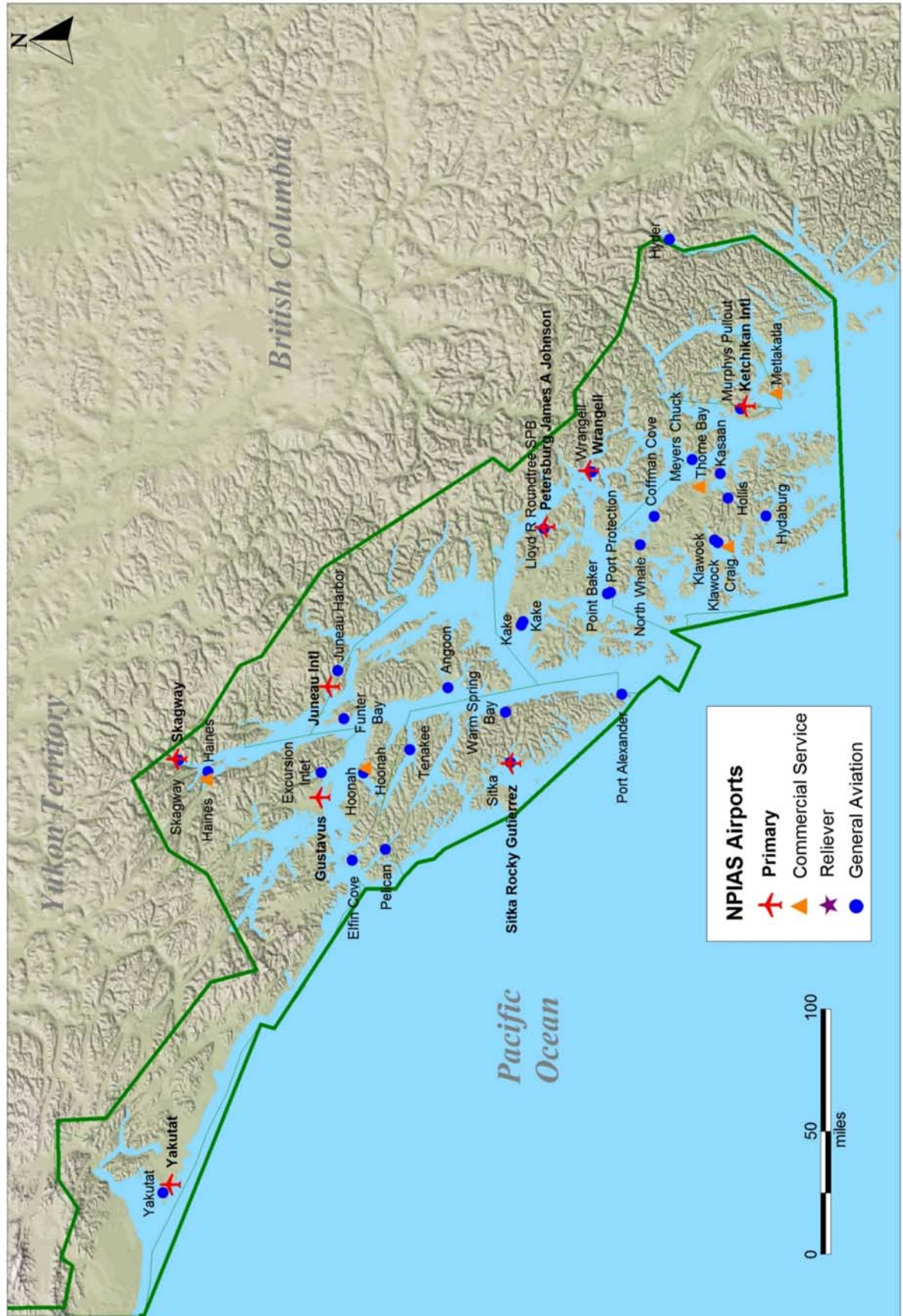
