

By The Numbers...


- Over 1 Million Drone Registrations
 - 160,000+ registered for commercial use
- Over 86,000 Remote Pilots
- ~18,000 Airspace Authorizations
- Over **1,500** Operational Waivers
- 355 Emergency Authorizations for Hurricane Response
- 3 Drone Delivery Partnerships
- 12 UAS Type Certification Projects
- 3 Certified Agricultural Operators

On The Horizon...

- UAS Integration Pilot Program
 - Evaluations ongoing
 - At least 10 to be selected
 - Agreements in place by May 7
- Future Rules
 - 1. Remote Identification
 - 2. Routine Operations at Night and Over People
 - 3. Critical Infrastructure Protection

Enabling Expanded Operations

UAS Integration Pilot Program

- 149 complete lead applicant proposals submitted, from geographically diverse state, local, and tribal government entities
- DOT Secretary Chao will select a minimum of 10 participants
- Evaluations on track to support selection by May 2018
- Program sunsets after three years, unless extended by the Secretary
