



# Rulemaking Governance & Prioritization Approach



#### Strategic Prioritization

- Addresses top-down, bottom-up and emergent rulemaking needs
- Southern Capabilities

- Supports workload balancing
- No "one-size-fits-all" approaches
  - Process flexibility expand/contract in response to complexity



- Enables parallel work streams and non-sequential approaches
- Early Engagement
  - Proactively engages industry stakeholders
  - Incorporates feedback loops early and through a longer period of policy development

    - RAMP Re-assignment
- Office of Rulemaking
  - Integrated Rulemaking Plan
