

DRONES WITHOUT REMOTE ID: FLYING IN A FRIA



- A FRIA is an FAA-recognized Identification Area where drones can be flown if they don't have Remote ID equipment
- To operate a drone without Remote ID in a FRIA;
 - Both the drone and the pilot must be located within the FRIA's boundaries throughout the operation
 - The pilot of the drone must be able to see it at all times throughout the operation
- Locations of approved FRIAs are available on the FAA's UAS Data Delivery System
